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City of Evansville Hosts Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for New Aquatic Center & Park

EVANSVILLE, Wisc. (May 31, 2024) – The City of Evansville invites all local media to a ribboncutting ceremony to mark the grand opening of the new Evansville Aquatic Center and upgrades at Larson Acres Park (formerly West Side Park).

The new community aquatic center includes a six-lane pool, aqua climbing wall, diving board, slides, zero-depth entry area, and accommodations for individuals of all ages and abilities. The center is also equipped with locker rooms, showers, a concession area, admissions desk, staff and lifeguard support spaces.

Upgrades to Larson Acres Park — dedicated in honor of Don and Virginia Larson whose family farmed the land for decades and made a generous donation in support of the project — include renovated soccer fields, new ballfield, softball field, central open green space, multiuse trails, parking spaces, and new stormwater system.
