Apprentice Electric Line Worker

The City of Evansville is accepting applications for the position of an Apprentice Electric Line Worker within the Water & Light Utility. We are seeking an energetic individual with a high level of reliability, accountability, and accuracy. This is a full-time position which is responsible for day-to-day operations, maintenance and repair of electrical systems.

Applicants must obtain a journeyman certification through the course of their apprenticeship. Applicant must have the ability to perform strenuous physical labor and heavy manual tasks including climbing and working with energized lines. Knowledge of safety rules and good communication skills are important. Requirements include a high school diploma or equivalent and a valid driver's license. A Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with air brakes and combination trailer endorsement is preferred. A DMV background check, drug test and a pre-employment physical exam will be required. This position requires after-hours emergency repairs, with evening, weekend and Holiday on-call duty. Applicants must be able to respond to these situations in a reasonable time.

This position offers a competitive starting wage of \$33.88 for a Step 1 Apprentice. Evansville offers an excellent benefit package including health care, dental, vision, life insurance, longevity bonus, retirement and more.
