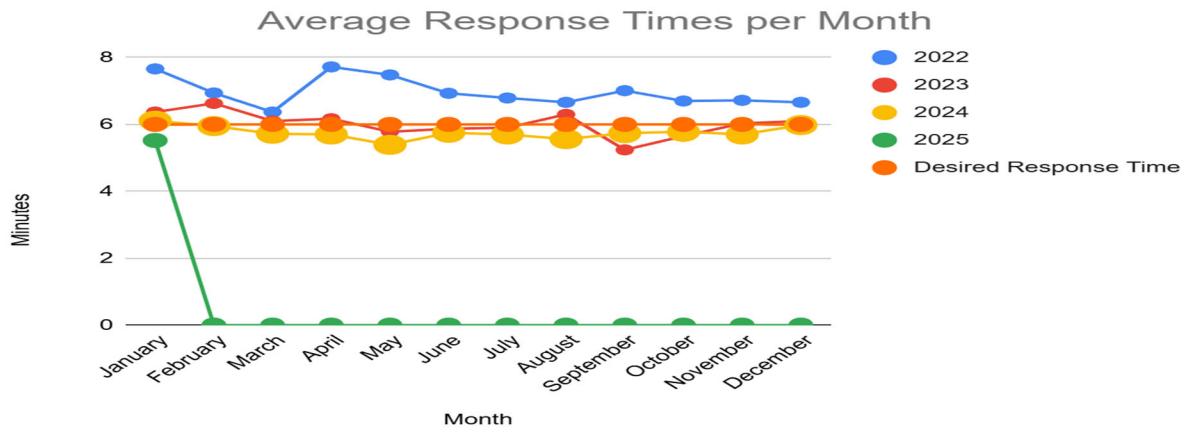
1. Calls for Service:
