- 1. Call to order at 6:36pm.
- 2. Roll call: Abbey Barnes, Ben Corridon, Shawn Dunphy, Sue Berg (chair). Excused: Jim Brooks, Lindsey Kennedy, Shirley Pate.
- 3. Motion to approve the agenda made by Ben Corridon, seconded by Shawn Dunphy. Motion carried.
