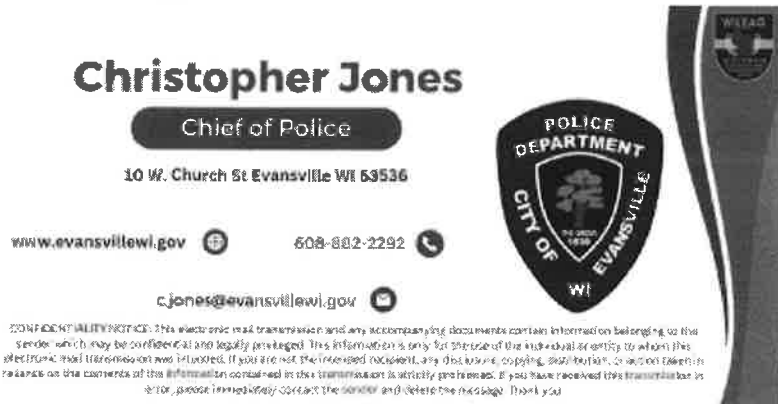

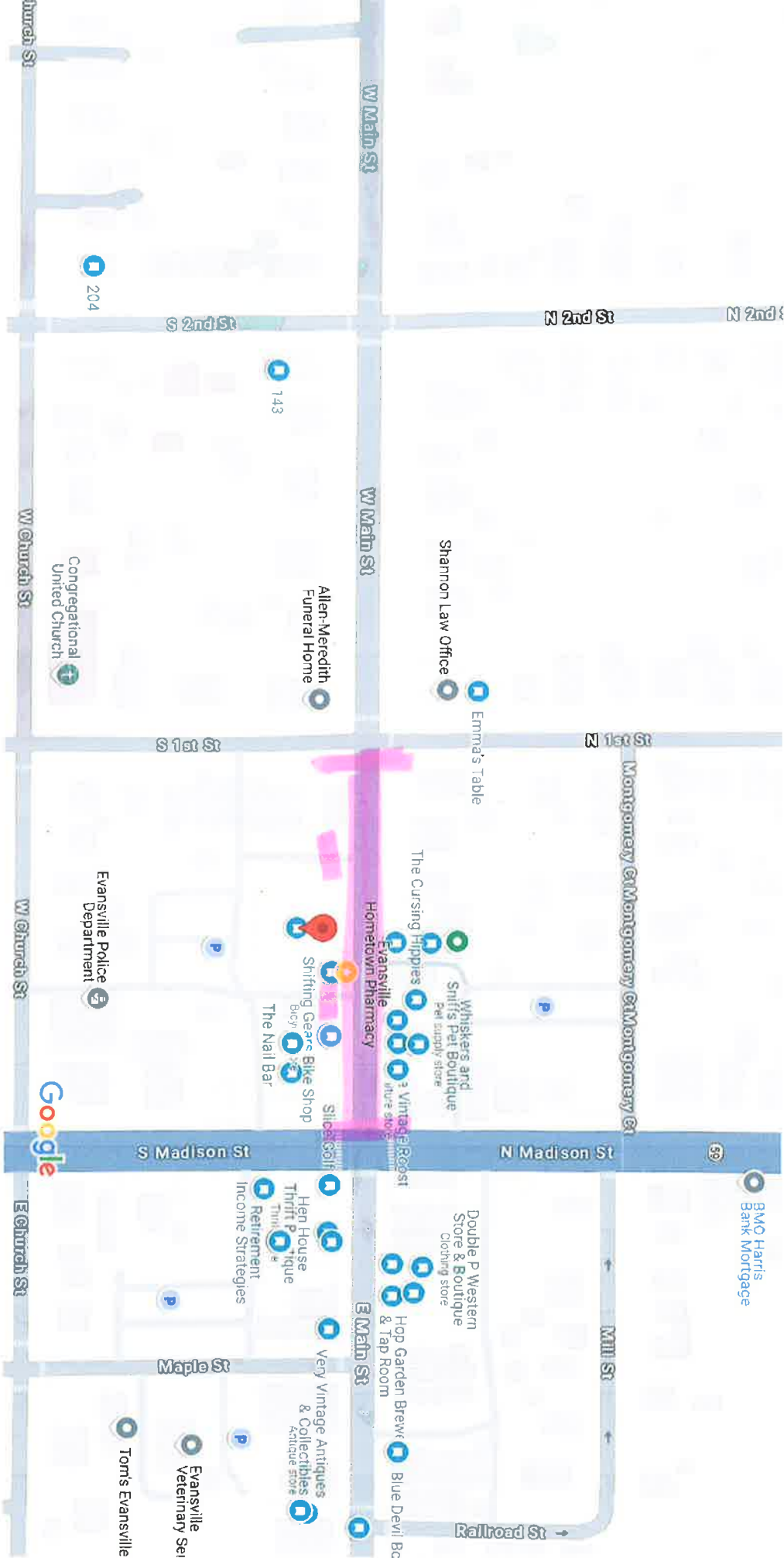

➤ **Training:**

- Lt Reilly became certified in PBT Calibration.
- Chief Jones and Lt Reilly attended an alcohol policy workshop.

- Police Commission met on 6/18 to give approve conditional offers to two new officers. The new officers are scheduling their psychological and medical evaluations. They are also scheduled for their Physical Readiness Training at Blackhawk Technical College on July 11th. Two spots are being held at Blackhawk Tech for them to attend the academy starting in August.
- Officers Hanson and Schwark have moved on to phase of fielding training. They are both doing well.

➤ **Accreditation:**

- Lt. Reilly and Quinn have been reviewing accreditation files.

➤ **Notable calls:**

- Officer Tway was notified of a male who went missing from a care facility. Officer Tway, along with the Rock County Sheriff's Office, Green County Sheriff's Department and the Evansville Fire District began searching the area for the subject. Lt Reilly eventually took command of the incident and utilized a drone from the sheriff's office to check the area with no locate. A Silver Alert was issued through the Department of Justice and a reverse 911 was issued to the entire county. A sighting of the male was report at Gibb's Lake Park and the area was searched extensively before it was learned the sighting was not the subject in question. Rock County Emergency Management then contacted Chief Jones to inquire about having air units begin checking the area. The request was made. Lt Reilly then coordinated with Wisconsin Emergency Management who dispatched the WI National Guard, the Civil Air Patrol, and the WI State Patrol into the area. Lt Reilly coordinated the area units to search likely areas. Additionally, contact was made with WI K9 SOS search team, who dispatched several search dogs to the area. Upon their arrival search efforts were coordinated with them, EVPD and EVFD employees. EMS was also put on standby during this time. Another reverse 911 was issued to the area to have people check their cameras, outbuildings, etc. The area was extensively search for several hours by the K-9 teams, aircraft, and citizens with no locate. At 11 p.m. the search was halted. The following morning the subject was located safe in a residence on N South Fifth St. A big thanks for everyone who assisted with this call.
- Officers responded to a domestic disturbance. After investigation a male was arrested for Domestic Disorderly Conduct and False Imprisonment.

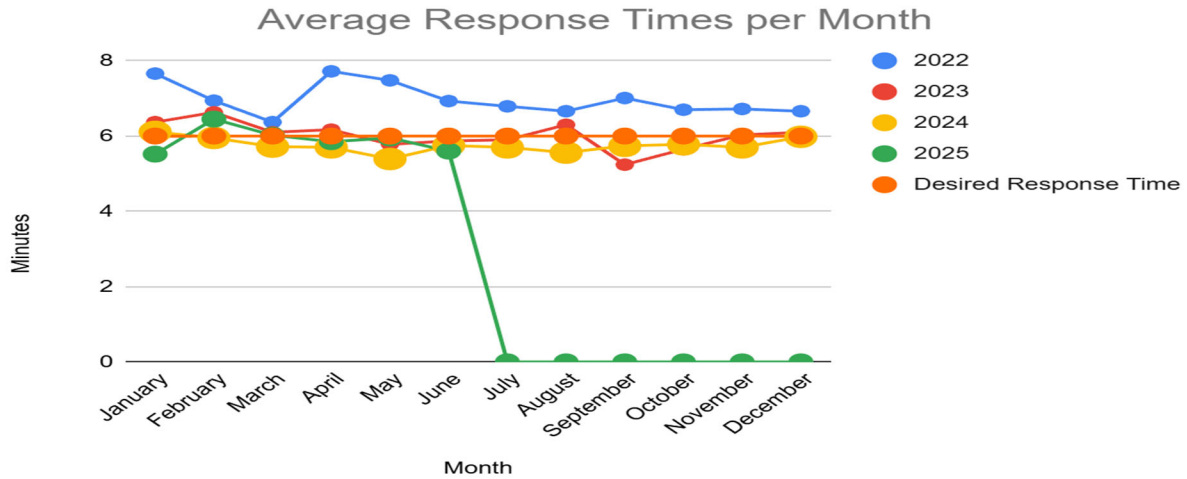
