- Sgt. Rittenhouse and Ofc. Johnson attended Wisconsin Crime Lab training put on by the DOJ
- Sgt. Rittenhouse attended Vehicle Contacts Instructors Course and is now certified to teach in house or at the police academy
- Lt. Jones heard back that he was accepted into the front line supervisors course to be held in August for two week. This is sponsored by the Department of Justice

- Planning continues with Building a Safer Evansville on Evansville Night Out
- Planning for the 4th of July celebrations occurred. Det. Sgt. Rittenhouse was in charge of the operations plan and scheduling for the PD this year

Monthly Update:

Technology/Equipment/Building Update:

- Chief Reese and Lt. Jones are in the process of gathering information on a generator for the PD and City Hall. This is in both budgets to be done this year.
- The portable video system was placed at Lake Leota Park through the 4th of July. This system is just one more layer of security to monitor the events at the park
- City Administer Sergeant and Chief Reese met outside the PD to discuss placement of the generator, general appearance of the PD and way to enhance accessibility as it relates to elderly and disabled visitors to the PD. Chief Reese will be contacting painting contractors to obtain quotes on painting the building
- Lt. Jones completed a grant for a live scan fingerprinter. We are waiting to hear back on award status

Police Commission/staffing:

- We received a total of 17 applications for the full and part time police officer positions available. 2 qualified to be tested immediately and testing took place on 06/30/21. Oral interviews will occur the week of July 5th. One individual will take the written exam for part time police officer on July 9th

- No new updates

Notable incidents/calls (By Sergeant Reilly 05/20/21-06/20/21):

05/22/21 – A pride sign was stolen. No suspects were able to be identified. The case remains open pending any identification of a suspect

05/29/21 – A subject was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated after he hit a mailbox and fled the scene. Officer Nankee later located the vehicle at a gas station and arrested the driver

06/02/21 – Officers were dispatched to a suspicious activity on the west side of the city. While searching the area, Officer Tway located a stolen vehicle from Madison. While on scene Officer Tway observed other suspicious vehicles in the area which ultimately lead to two other stolen vehicles fleeing from him. The recovered stolen vehicle had several stolen items of property from the area and were later returned to their respective owners. The vehicle was turned over the owner. While on scene with the vehicle Sgt Rittenhouse observed an individual laying on the ground in between some houses. The Rock County Sheriff's Officer and a K-9 from Dane County Sheriff's Department were called to assist in searching the area but the person was not located. Officers later took a report of a stolen vehicle from the city. This vehicle was pursued by law enforcement in Jefferson County but it was not apprehended. The vehicle is still missing at this time. The case remains under investigation.

06/13/21 – Officers along with the Evansville Fire Department responded to a vehicle fire on S Fifth St at Badger Dr. The vehicle was a total loss

06/14/21 – Chief Reese, Lt Jones, Sgt Reilly, and Ofc Laufenberg conducted traffic enforcement on Garfield Ave due to the number of complaints we have received regarding speeding vehicles and other traffic violations. Officers were staged at intersections on Garfield Ave from First St to Third St from 7:30a – 8:30a. Officers only observed one speed violation. The driver was issued a warning for the violation

06/15/21 – Officer Tway observed a vehicle acting suspiciously and made a traffic stop on the vehicle. Through the investigation the driver was found to be in possession of MDMA (Ecstasy) and taken to the Rock County Jail

06/16/21 – A resident reported that their custom Pride Flag was stolen from their residence. A few persons of interest were identified and interviewed. The case remains under investigation

06/20/21 – Officer Nankee took a report of two stolen vehicles from the same residence. It was reported that the vehicles were locked with the keys in them. UW-Madison PD later reported that one of the vehicles was involved in a hit in run after UWPD attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle and fled from the officer

- Since this report by Sgt. Reilly we've received an additional 3 reports of stolen autos. One has been received. We have recovered a total of 3 cars of the 6 that were stolen in the month of June
- 06/30/21 Officer Laufenberg made an arrest for Domestic DC and Criminal Trespassing
- Chief Reese assisted with the barn fire on HY14 and with other calls that came in during the same time frame. See photos

Other Concerns/Comments:

- In case you're curious we had 12 fireworks complaints phoned into the PD from July 2nd to July 4th
- No one was taken to jail during the 4th of July celebrations. We have noticed the years we staff well there tends to be a decrease in arrests v. years we are short staffed
- Although calls for service were down in the month of June, which is to be expected given the types of calls we've needed to investigate. They are taking more time and follow up with then drives down self-initiated calls for service such as traffic stops
