(c) A written premise description along with a site plan describing the outdoor area sought to be added as an addendum to the licensed premises; said site plan, drawing or map also complying with and indicating all buildings and structures on the property, lot lines, setbacks, measurements, zoning uses or surrounding property, appropriate fencing, entrances and exits, safety and lighting, and any other requirements deemed necessary by the City Clerk, Chief of Police, or zoning officer. Premises for which a Temporary Class “B” beer or Temporary “Class B” wine license has been applied for on City property shall receive approval of the Common Council.

(d) The applicant shall have a certificate of insurance and shall name the City as an insured party as its interest may appear. The City Clerk shall be furnished with a copy of the certificate of insurance before the license is approved. Such coverage shall be primary and non-contributing with any insurance carried by the City.

(Code 1986, § 12.04(14), Ord2 2022-03, Ord. 2023-06)

Sec. 6-44. Operator's license.

(a) **Regular.** Application for an operator's license under § 125.17, Wis. Stats., shall state the name, residence, age, birthdate, and sex of the applicant, together with such other pertinent information as the City Clerk requires, and shall be issued by the Clerk for a period of no longer than two years to the renewal date of June 30, upon approval as detailed below.

(1) Submitted applications shall be referred by the City Clerk to the Police Department for review and recommendation. The Police Chief shall review each submitted application, perform a background check and recommend issuance or denial of the license.

(2) The Public Safety Committee will review the application and any recommendations from the Police Chief. The Public Safety Committee shall decide by majority of those voting whether to grant or deny a license to the applicant. The Public Safety Committee may attach any conditions and/or limitations to a granted operator license as they deem necessary.

(3) Upon the Public Safety Committee’s approval the City Clerk shall issue a regular operator license to an applicant.

(4) If an application is denied the applicant must wait at least six (6) months before they can apply for another operator license.

(b) Provisional license.

(1) Application for a provisional operator's license under Wis. Stats. § 125.17(5) shall be made to the City Clerk and shall state the name, residence, age, birthdate and sex of the applicant, together with such other pertinent information as the City Clerk requires. The provisional license shall be issued by the City Clerk following a background check and an approval recommendation by the Chief of Police.

- (2) A provisional license shall be issued only to a person who has applied for an operator's license under this section. The provisional license shall expire sixty (60) days after its issuance or when the operator's license is issued, whichever is sooner.
- (3) The City Clerk or the Public Safety Committee may revoke the provisional license if it discovers that the holder of the provisional license made a false statement on the application for a provisional license or a regular operator's license.
- (4) The provisions of Wis. Stats. § 125.17(5) are hereby adopted in their entirety, and any conflict between this section and that statute as it may exist from time to time shall be resolved in favor of the statutory provision.

(c) Violations. The City has generally found convictions for the following offenses are substantially related to the duties and responsibilities associated with an operator's license. For purposes of these guidelines, any pending prosecution shall be treated as a conviction.

(1) **OWI** (all collectively referred to herein as "OWI"): Operating Under the Influence of an Intoxicant or Other Drugs, under Wis. Stat. § 346.63, local ordinances in conformity therewith, or other similar laws from other states, (commonly referred to as OWI, OWPBAC, PBAC, DWI, or DUI); or driving any vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs; or injuring any person or damaging any property while driving under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.

a) The City has generally found OWI convictions within one (1) year of application for a License are grounds for denial of a License.

b) The City has also generally found two or more OWI convictions within five (5) years of application for a license can be grounds for denial of a License.

(2) **Underage Drinking:** Any underage drinking conviction which is the same as or similar to Wis. Stat. § 125.07(3) or (4) is substantially related to the duties and responsibilities associated with alcohol beverage licenses.

a) Any such underage drinking conviction within one (1) year of application for a license is typically grounds for denial.

b) Two or more such underage drinking convictions within five (5) year of application for a license are typically grounds for denial.

(3) **Service to Underage Persons.** Any service to underage persons conviction which is the same as or similar to Wis. Stat. § 125.07(1)(a) is substantially related to the duties and responsibilities associated with alcohol beverage licenses.

a) Two (2) or more service to underage persons within one (1) year of application for a License is typically grounds for denial.

(4) Drug Offense. The City has generally found that the following convictions are substantially related to the duties and responsibilities associated with alcohol beverage licenses: manufacturing, distributing or delivering a controlled substance or controlled substance analog under Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1); possessing with intent to manufacture, distribute or deliver, a controlled substance or controlled substance analog under Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1m); possessing, with intent to manufacture, distribute or deliver, or manufacturing, distributing or delivering a controlled substance or controlled substance analog under a federal law or law of another state that is substantially similar to Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1) or (1m); possessing any of the materials listed in Wis. Stat. § 961.65 with intent to manufacture methamphetamine under that section or under federal law or a law of another state that is substantially similar to Wis. Stat. § 961.65; or possessing controlled substances as regulated by Chapter 961, Wis. Stats.

a) The City has generally found such convictions within one (1) year of application for a License are grounds for denial.

b) The City has generally found two or more such convictions within five (5) years of application for License can be grounds for denial of a License.

(5) Overall Conviction Record, Felons, or Other Offenses. No operator's license shall be issued under this guideline to any person who has:

a) Been convicted of a felony that substantially relates to the circumstances of the licensed activity unless the person has been duly pardoned;

b) Been deemed a habitual law offender;

c) Convictions not specifically listed above shall also be grounds for denial of a License, as reasonably determined in the sound discretion of the City; or

d) Any intentionally or accidentally omitted any violation it will be considered a false application, resulting in the delay and or possible denial of the application.

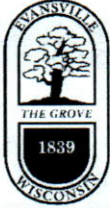

Public Safety Report

➤ **Training:**

- The Janesville Police Department and the Rock County Sheriff's Office hosted ALERRT (Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training) at the Evansville High School. Several area agencies attended the training, including EVPD, EVEMS, and EVFD. A big thank you to all of the agencies that attended and put on this training, along with the school district for allowing use of the school.

➤ **Community Outreach:**

- Lt Reilly met with 5th Grade students at TRIS to talk about law enforcement and answer questions.
- Lt Reilly and Sgt Johnson attended a career fair at Blackhawk Technical College. Lt Reilly also assisted with providing students mock interviews to prepare for hiring processes.
- BlueScope hosted a luncheon for first responders as part of Spread Goodness Day at the Fire Department.
- Officers assisted with leading the Wrestling Team in and out of town for the state championship.

➤ **Calls for service:** As of 03/27/25 – March 2025: 1012 March 2026: 1058

➤ **Police Commission/Staffing:**

- A conditional offer was given to an applicant; however, they were not able to meet the conditions and the offer was rescinded. Lt Reilly is continuing to review applications and scheduling interviews to fill the last open position.

➤ **Accreditation:**

- Accreditation files continue to be reviewed. Our assessment date is scheduled for June.

➤ **Notable calls:**

- Sgt. Tway and Ofc. Ritter were dispatched to a disturbance between a male and a female, but confirmed the disturbance was only verbal and did not have criteria to arrest the male for domestic disorderly conduct. However, Sgt. Tway and Ofc. Ritter attempted to take the male into custody due to being incapacitated by alcohol which resulted in a physical altercation. During the altercation, Sgt. Tway suffered a sprained wrist. Once the male half was in custody, he repeatedly made threats that he was going to shoot the officers. The male was later arrested and taken to the Rock County Jail for Threats to a Law Enforcement Officer and Resist/Obstruct an Officer, but after a second physical altercation with the suspect while getting him medically cleared at Mercy.
- Ofc. Delgado investigated a harassment complaint for an AI generated photo that was created of the victim and then shared on Snapchat. Ofc. Delgado discovered the suspect found a picture of the victim and used AI to depict her in her underwear and additional sexually explicit details. Ofc. Delgado located the juvenile suspect who confessed to altering the photo and sharing it via Snapchat. The suspect was issued a citation for Unauthorized Use of a Computerized Communication Device.
- Sgt. Tway and Ofc. Derrickson received a report of an unconscious female who intentionally took pills in an attempt to commit suicide. Officers found the female conscious who said she wanted to die and took a number of pills along with a full bottle of wine. Force was used by the officers while detaining the female for being incapacitated and suicidal. The victim later sought voluntary medical treatment.

Public Safety Report

- Sgt. Johnson and Ofc. Hanson received a welfare check and numerous unwanted subject complaints for a subject that was using bathrooms at businesses for long periods of time. The subject appeared to be under the influence of drugs, but officers had no criteria to arrest or detain the subject as dispatched claimed he had no warrants, based on the fake name he provided. Sgt. Johnson later searched the subject's fake name and discovered it was used as an alias for an individual with multiple warrants throughout Wisconsin. Sgt. Johnson and Ofc. Hanson located the subject, confirmed his real identity, and placed him under arrest for the warrants and a number of other charges including Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Additionally, a substance located on the subject later tested positive for methamphetamine.
- Ofc. Derrickson was dispatched to a physical disturbance between a male and a female and items were also being thrown. Ofc. Derrickson discovered a verbal altercation started after the male tried to get the female to stop smoking weed which resulted in the female throwing unknown objects at the male. Ofc. Derrickson later arrested the female half for Domestic Battery and Domestic Disorderly Conduct for her actions in the altercation.
- Ofc. Hanson received a report of multiple cellular accounts that were opened in the victim's name using his social security number. It is unknown how the victim's social security number was obtained, but Ofc. Hanson is working with the victim to assist with protecting his identity and reporting the issue to the Social Security Bureau.
- Ofc. Derrickson received a report of a disturbance in which a male and female were reportedly yelling, items were being slammed, and sounded like they were being physical. Ofc. Derrickson made contact at the residence after hearing yelling from outside and spoke with a female who was crying. The male half was detained a short time later due to being uncooperative, trying to shut the door on Ofc. Derrickson, and being aggressive towards the officers on scene. The male half was eventually arrested for violating a bond condition to maintain absolute sobriety.
- Ofc. Hanson investigated a traffic complaint for a vehicle that was reported to be operated by an intoxicated subject. Ofc. Hanson located the vehicle at Culvers and spoke with the driver who had multiple indicators of being under the influence of alcohol. The driver was ultimately arrested for OWI 1st offense following standardized field sobriety testing. The driver was also issued a citation for Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration.
- Ofc. Schmidt investigated a fraud after a female victim reported a check she wrote was attempted to be cashed by an unknown subject. The female reported she mailed a check to Discover in the amount of \$287.96 on 02/13/26, but received a late notice from Discover one month later for the above transaction. The victim canceled/stopped the check due to her belief it was lost in the mail. On 03/20/26, the victim was contacted by Lake Ridge Bank who advised someone tried to cash her lost/canceled check. The check appeared to be washed as it was made out to an unknown subject in the amount of \$5,980. Ofc. Schmidt is currently working with Sgt. Johnson on this ongoing investigation.
- Sgt. Johnson received a report from a business owner in Evansville that someone attempted to use her business' debit card to purchase a \$1,600 laptop. The victim
